Description

During specific circumstances when Active IQ Unified Manager's OCIE service will not start, it could be due to a corrupted `Server.Keystore` and or `Server.Truststore`.

To resolve this, it may be necessary to replace the `server.truststore` and or `server.keystore` with an uncorrupted version.

When replacing `Server.truststore` or `Server.keystore`, it may be necessary to change the ownership. To accomplish this, follow the steps below.
